his is one of those products which is superb for all animals that drink water, fish and amphibians excepted! **Dyna-Pro** may be added to feed, put in water, or drenched directly into mouths; whichever works best for the situation.

While other probiotic formulas merely supply one or more strains of live beneficial bacteria, the use of which can result in bloating, **Dyna-Pro** uses a fermentation extract which nourishes and encourages the naturally available beneficial bacteria to reproduce and multiply. A few years ago we spoke to a German Grand Prix (dressage) visitor and asked him what they fed their horses to keep them so healthy and colic-free. His answer was "silage." Silage is a fermentation product and it is this that keeps their intestines so healthy. In this country, we do not feed silage but the **DynaPro** should more than make up for that.

It comes down to the intestinal pH balance. Without correct, alkaline pH, the beneficial intestinal bacterial colonies will not thrive and can go dormant. These "good" bacteria are our horses' first defense against such "invaders" as viruses, "bad" bacteria and parasites so it behooves us to encourage healthy colonies. Of course, the "invaders" really are always around just waiting for an opportunity to come out of their dormancy and take advantage of a weakened, or acidic, condition. With horses, many stressors can cause an acidic gut including but not limited to: weather changes, hauling, competition, being scared, drinking chlorinated water, etc. making the use of **DynaPro** even more important at these times.

It depends somewhat on the stability of the individual horse for emotional factors, but

- •We give it daily to all equine youngsters under the age of 2 since their digestive tracts are not mature until then. Mature, healthy pasture potatoes may do fine with a dose once a week, but working horses also will also need it daily.
